Today we learn how to form beads of acrylic, control it in liquid form and mix with the right ratios. <p><u>12pm – Break</u></p> <p><u>1pm – Overlays</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Once we've worked for a while on a practice sheet, we will move onto applying an overlay of Liquid and Powder to the nail for strength. <p><u>2.30pm – Nail Art</u></p> <p>Let's spend the afternoon making cool things out of liquid and powder. Today, learn how to complete the same set of nails using tips instead. • We’ll teach you the pros and cons of Tips vs Forms and when you should choose each option. <p><u>1.30pm – Break</u></p> <p><u>2.30pm – Liquid & Powder Backfill</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Now that we have a firm grasp on Liquid and Powder Application, it’s time to start learning how to maintain it.
