Day One	9am-5pm	<p><u>9am – Welcome - Liquid and Powder Refresher</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This is a full day workshop centered on Liquid and Powder, recapping everything you have learned so far. Use this time to troubleshoot any issues you have come across and squash any bad habits that have crept in while practicing. <p><u>9.10am – Natural Nail Prep and Form Application</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Iron out bad habits that have crept in and troubleshoot issues that you're having, <p><u>10am – Natural-Look Extensions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Perfecting side walls, lower arches, cuticle blending, structure and c-curves. <p><u>11.10am – French Extensions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For brides, competitions or for clients who prefer a clean, classic look, mastering French is important. We focus on clean lines, arched smiles, and correct ratios. <p><u>12.20pm – Lunch</u></p> <p><u>1.20pm – Reverse French Extensions</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Let's push ourselves and see how far we can take this. Exaggerated c-curves, paper thin free edges, and 50-50 ratios are key features of competition-style nails but what's most important is consistency to the extreme. <p><u>2.30pm – Filing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> There shouldn't be much filing now, but this will get you perfect nails every time. <p><u>3.40pm – Maintenance Demos</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Backfills and Rebalances – the service you will provide most often. <p><u>4pm – Evaluation Preparation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Let's finish the day going over everything you need to know for tomorrow. 	<p>We'll be working on each other so please come with at least 5 naked nails.</p> <p>In case we have odd numbers, it's best that these naked nails are on your 'easy' hand.</p>

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Day Two	9am-5pm	<p><u>9am – Welcome and Full Set Prep</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go over the criteria for your Evaluation before getting stuck in! <p><u>9.15am – Liquid and Powder Full Set Evaluation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will complete a Full Set of Sculpted French Acrylics. You may use our products for Evaluations however as brush quality can influence the outcome we highly recommend bringing your own brush. Any Cover Powder used should be blended out to either Blush or Clear powder at the cuticle. Having Cover Powder at the cuticle will affect our critique. Please don't use any glitters as this affects what we can see to evaluate Please don't use Top Coat – buff to a High Shine so that we can evaluate your application better Please create a strong square shape – again this gives us more to evaluate Please extend the nail by a minimum of 2mm above the fingertip for the same reason Use tips, forms, or one hand of each – whatever you're most likely to do in salon <p><u>12.15pm – Evaluations</u></p> <p><u>12.30pm – Break</u></p> <p><u>1.30pm – Gel Polish Refresher</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Watch optional demos on Plain and French Gel Polish Application and spend the rest of your time practicing whatever you need to, helped by your Educator. <p><u>3pm – Gel Polish Evaluation Prep</u></p> <p><u>3.15pm – Gel Polish Evaluation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will use our products for this Evaluation. Square nails will give us more to evaluate We'd really like to evaluate 5 French nails and 5 nails in an opaque colour. If you use shimmer, you'll hide half of what we're trying to help you with If you go overboard with cuticle oil, you'll hide even more 90 minute time limit. <p><u>4.45pm – Evaluations</u></p>	<p>You will need a model for each of your Evaluations from 9.15am-12.15pm and 3.15pm-4.45pm.</p> <p>You cannot use the same model for both sessions – they each get a full set.</p> <p>These models are not shared. One model per student.</p> <p><i>You can choose to bring a model for the 1.30pm practice session but should otherwise be prepared to work with a buddy, having naked nails yourself. If you bring a model, they will be shared with your buddy.</i></p>
